Turkish Officers Acquitted Over Coup Plot

A Turkish court acquitted scores of active and retired military officers previously convicted of plotting to overthrow the government of then-Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdogan. It was a stunning reversal in a landmark case that had helped his Islamist-rooted government tame the once-paramount military.
